The mission of the *European Journal for Qualitative Research in Psychotherapy* is to provide an accessible forum for research that advances psychotherapy in Europe. We aim to be open and inclusive. While integrative psychotherapy is the focus of the journal, our interest extends to psychotherapeutic practice more generally, whether in Europe or further afield. We welcome contributions from diverse methodological and theoretical standpoints, as well as relevant literature reviews, critical explorations of methodology and philosophical research. Submissions of qualitative empirical research examples are particularly encouraged.

The first issue of this journal was originally created in 2006. The last issue was due in 2015 but with the sad and sudden death of Dr Ken Evans, its founder and Senior Editor, it was taken offline. Resurrected – and generously hosted by the European Association of Integrative Psychotherapy (EAIP) - the journal is reborn. Check out for our special inaugural volume which commemorates Ken Evans who spent many years promoting psychotherapy in Europe. We have reproduced his full, unpublished, 2015 issue as Volume 8 (2018).
